I will acquire the Venturing attitude that seeks truth in all things and adventure on the frontiers of our changing world.

Venturing is a youth program for young adults in high school and college that provides leadership and service opportunities in a friendly and adventurous environment. Venturing's purpose is to provide positive experiences to help young people mature and to prepare them to become responsible and caring Americans. Our program is designed to build character, promote citizenship, and develop personal and mental fitness. The objective is to plan and conduct both social and high adventure activities that are fun, challenging, and test individual skills and teamwork. Most of all, it's about the crazy things we do when we're backpacking, sailing, whitewater rafting, kayaking, and kicking it in the outdoors.
